

Interested in Court Supervision Thru the Mail?

Are you eligible? (All must apply.)

- a. Your ticket is marked “**NO COURT APPEARANCE REQUIRED**” at the bottom of your ticket.
- b. You have not been placed on court supervision within the past 12 months in any court in the State of Illinois.
- c. You do NOT have a CDL or are under 21.

What does it mean?

- a. You agree to waive your trial and attorney rights and wish to plead guilty to the citation.
- b. You are agreeing to a fine and court costs of total fine and cost \$325.00, which will then place you on 3 months of court supervision, beginning the date the order is entered.
- c. Instead of a conviction, court supervision does not register on your driver’s license as a moving violation.*

How do you sign up?

- a. Contact the State’s Attorneys office at (309) 478-5694 and a form will be mailed to you.
- b. Read, agree to and fill out the forms provided with your name, driver’s license number, offense, and ticket number (located at top of citation), and return the form by the date provided to you.
- c. Send this form to the Circuit Clerk-Traffic Division for entry of the order with assistance of the State’s Attorney and Court.

* Exceptions will apply if you hold a **CDL** (commercial driver’s license), **out of state driver’s license**, or are **under the age of 21**. Speak to your prosecutor or obtain private legal counsel for assistance.
